Basic Features of the Megaphone

- With Φ6.35mm wired microphone input, handy microphone and single channel UHF wireless microphone.
- Wired microphone, handy microphone and wireless microphone volume control
- MP3 double decoding and recording in MP3 & WMA function. Wired microphone, handy microphone, wireless microphone and external audio input can be recorded to MP3.
- With over discharge protection function.

Trouble shooting

If you have any problem with the system, please check the main power and batteries for microphone sets and rechargeable battery built-in. If you are using a new battery, please make sure you have put it in a correct polarity.

For the following problems:

Screaming from the speaker

- 1. Please adjust the speaker volume to the minimum.
- 2. Adjust the transmitter volume control to a low level.
- 3. Change the speaker direction to avoid direct feedback.

Noise or abrupt stop

- 1. Check the accumulator to see if it is low in voltage
- 2. Built-in battery low, please use DC adaptor instead to power the system.
- 3. Check the cable connection to the speaker. The cable might be broken after a long time use.
- 4. Possible frequency interference with local transmission. Please contact the dealer to change channels for better reception.


No voice heard

- 1. One of the powers is not turned, please check all power source and make sure they are all ON.
- 2. The volume control knobs are turned to lowest level. Make sure they are proper in sound.
- 3. Check the microphone battery room to make sure the battery is weak power or not. If the battery in no power, replace it.
- Check the USB/SD card port is broken or not. Check the USB/SD card is in good condition or not. If it is broken, replace it.

NOTE: Take out the battery to avoid its acid damaging the components of the transmitter if you are not going to use it for a period of time.

How to use the wireless Lavalier Microphone?

- 1. Open the battery door of the transmitter to make sure the AA battery were installed in connect + polarity. Close the cover.
- 2. Plug the lavalier microphone or headset microphone into the jack.
- 3. Switch on the power of the transmitter and when the LED is on, it is ready to work.
- 4. After use, you have to take the battery out of the transmitter to avoid battery leaking to damage the transmitter.



How to use a wired microphone

Put the plug of the wired mic into the port of wire mic input, adjust the volume to require perfect sound effect.



How to use the audio input

Connect the cable of the CD/MD etc audio sources into AUX IN jack to get the music sound amplifying. Adjust the volume depend on your requirement.


HOW TO CHARGE THE BUILT-IN DC12V6AH LI-ION BATTERY


- When you want to charge the built-in DC12V6AH li-ion battery, turn
 off the main pa amplifier, plug the AC cable to the main pa amplifier
 and the local electricity socket, at this moment, the LED is in red. When
 full charged, the LED is dim.
- 2. Charge time is 6-8 hours.
- 3. Charge temperature: 0°C-45°C. Please make sure your correct charge temperature when you are charging the li-ion battery.
- 4. Discharge temperature: -20°C-55°C. Please make sure your correct discharge temperature when you are discharging the li-ion battery.
- 5. Storage temperature: -5°C-35°C. Please make sure your correct storage temperature when you store the li-ion battery.
- Working hours after full charged is around 5 hours for MP3 play in Maximum volume, 3 hours for alarm but for the microphone amplifying is around 10 hours.
- 7. The main pa amplifier is designed with charge auto protection circuit, discharge protection circuit and overcharge protection circuit.
- 8. Any incorrect operation for the charging will lead to the risks of accidents happen.

How to use the handheld wireless Microphone

- 1 Open the battery cover.
- 2 Put the battery into the compartment and make sure you have a right polarity before you use it.
- 3 Turn the switch to \mathbf{ON} and you can use the microphone now.
- 4 Please take the battery out if you are not going to use it for a period of time.

At this time, the USB or SD is flashing in 1Hz (the target disk is flashing). Press ▷ I/REC again to stop the recording. The data is recorded in the last song of the present disk.





Remote controller operation



1. 
2. MI/RECORD: Press this key to play and pause the MP3.Press and hold more than 2 seconds to MIC/AUX recording function. Press again to stop the recording.
